

1. Exhibit shall not obstruct the view of other exhibits nor operate in any manner objectionable to other exhibitors. All lighting within the exhibit must be arranged and operated without distracting from other exhibits. All demonstrations shall be confined to the space allotted to each exhibitor. Activities must not interfere with normal traffic flow, nor infringe on normal conversations in nearby exhibits. Any exhibit consistently disturbing others may be closed.

Linear booths must adhere to a maximum height of 10 ft. of display in the rear of booth. Island booths must adhere to a minimum height of 10 ft. from the ground to the bottom of any display above booth. If you request and receive approval to exceed height restrictions you must be able to present written approval from WM Symposia, Inc. Show Management onsite.

2 Any booth design over 400 sq. ft. requires advance written approval. Exhibitor must submit their booth design to WM Symposia, Inc. Show Management for approval at least 60 days prior to move in. Please send plans to WM Symposia, Inc. Exhibits Manager.

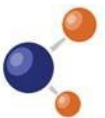
3. No hazardous, radioactive or other dangerous materials shall be brought into the exhibit area.

4. Nothing shall be posted on, nailed, screwed, or otherwise attached to columns, walls, floors, drapes or other parts of the building, structure or furniture.

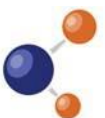
5. Dismantling – the exhibitor agrees not to dismantle their booth or to do any packing before the final closing hour of the exhibition which is 13:30 on Wednesday. Exhibitors who attempt to dismantle or pack prior to the final closing hour of the exhibition are at risk of losing the discounted returning exhibitor rate for next year’s conference, and may be excluded from the current conference until the final closing hour.

6. Security – 24-hour security personnel will be provided beginning when exhibitor freight is delivered to the exhibition floor on Friday and will continue through 19:00 on Wednesday. However, WM Symposia, Inc. does not assume any liability for exhibitor’s property. No bailment or trust is created. The prudent exhibitor should not leave valuable articles unprotected.

7. Any assigning, subletting, or apportionment of the whole or any part of the space allotted is not valid unless approved in writing, in advance, by WM Symposia, Inc. Only one company name will be listed per booth number, companies may request exceptions by contacting WM Symposia, Inc. Show Management.



8. The exhibitor agrees to assume all risks of loss, injury, theft or damage of any kind or nature whatsoever to any exhibitor, its invitees or agents, or property, including to any person, or goods, merchandise, chattels, papers and business records or other property which may be in or come into the exhibitor's possession during the course of the exhibit, including in the course of assembling or disassembling the exhibit, and to assume all liability for damage to property, person or persons arising from or related to the exhibitor's activities related to the conference, including accidental or other causes incidental to movement and operation of exhibitor, and thereby releases WM Symposia, Inc., its contractors and the Phoenix Convention Center from any liability whatsoever.
9. WM Symposia, Inc. reserves the right to relocate exhibitors if it becomes necessary. Every effort will be made to accommodate the exhibitor's location preference.
10. Exhibitor agrees to use the WM Symposia, Inc. attendee listing only for the purposes of invitations to visit your exhibit or to attend a hospitality event during this conference. This listing cannot be used for marketing or shared.
11. Exhibitors must comply with all conditions set forth by the Phoenix Convention Center. All food and beverage served by exhibitor must be provided by Aventura, the Phoenix Convention Food Service Contractor. Exhibitor agrees to not display any other alcohol in their booth. The exhibitor understands that this is a condition of use of the Phoenix Convention Center.
12. In case any part of the exhibition hall is destroyed or damaged so as to prevent WM Symposia, Inc. from permitting an exhibitor to occupy assigned spaced during any part or the whole of the exhibition period, or in case occupation of assigned space during any part or the whole exhibition period is prevented by strikes, Acts of God, national emergency or other causes beyond the control of WM Symposia, Inc., then the exhibitor will be charged for space only for the period the space was or could have been occupied by exhibitor; and the exhibitor hereby waives any claim against WM Symposia, Inc., its directors, officers, agents or employees for losses or damages which may arise in consequence of such inability to occupy assigned space.

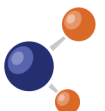


13. Exhibitor agrees to protect, indemnify and hold harmless WM Symposia, Inc., the Phoenix Convention Center and their respective officers, directors, employees and agents, against and from any all losses, costs, damages, liability or expenses including attorneys' fees and judgments arising from or by reason of any accident, bodily injury, property damage or other claims or occurrences to any person, including Exhibitor, its employees and agents, or any invites, arising out of or related to exhibitor's action or inaction related to the conference, including exhibiting or Exhibitor's occupancy or use of the exhibit premises, including during the conference or on and adjacent to the Phoenix Convention Center including storage and parking areas.

14. Exhibitor understands that WM Symposia, Inc. and the Phoenix Convention Center do not maintain insurance covering Exhibitor's property, damage or loss as well as injury to persons assembling or dismantling exhibit and that it is the sole responsibility of exhibitor to maintain such insurance. Exhibitor shall maintain general liability insurance in an amount not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to cover its potential liabilities under this Agreement, and shall name WM Symposia, Inc. as an additional insured under Exhibitor's liability policy for the period of this conference including move-in and move-out periods. Exhibitors must provide WM Symposia, Inc. Show Management proof of insurance 30 days prior to move-in. Please send certificate to WM Symposia, Inc. Exhibits Manager.

15. Exhibitor represents and warrants that its exhibit and product/service information shall comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act, its regulations and guidelines (collectively "ADA"). Exhibitor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless WM Symposia, Inc., its directors, officers, employees and agents, and each of them, from and against any and all claims and expenses, including attorneys' fees and costs, arising out of or related to Exhibitor's breach of this provision or noncompliance with any provision of the ADA.

16. Exhibitor understands they are responsible for relaying all relevant information, including but not limited to, schedule, policies, and terms and conditions to any third party they choose to hire.





17. Regulation Enforcement: WM Symposia, Inc. has sole and absolute discretion and authority to interpret and enforce all regulations of the conference and to make amendments and/or further regulations that are considered necessary or beneficial for the efficient operation of the conference. Such decisions shall be binding on all exhibitors. Failure to comply with these or any other regulations or amendments may be sufficient cause for WM Symposia, Inc. to require the immediate removal of the exhibit and/or the offending exhibitor. This may result in forfeiture of all further rights to exhibit at future conferences sponsored by WM Symposia, Inc. together with all fees paid. WM Symposia, Inc. may lease any forfeited space to another exhibitor. WM Symposia, Inc. reserves the right to reject any or all applications.

All matters not covered by these Terms and Conditions, and the interpretation, application, and enforcement of these Terms and Conditions, are subject to the decision of WM Symposia, Inc. in its sole and absolute discretion. These Terms and Conditions may be amended.
