DAY TOUR OF GRAND CANYON SOUTH RIM

0700 - 2000 (Boarding time is 0645, depart from the Monroe Street Entrance of the Hyatt Regency Phoenix)




Fee: \$195/person

The tour includes lunch, park entry fees, transportation and bottled water.

After departing the Phoenix metro area, our tour travels through the expansive Sonoran Desert filled with the native saguaro cactus. The scenery begins to change as we increase in elevation and views of the cactus fade into pine trees. As we continue further into Northern Arizona, we will travel the outskirts of the Route 66 town of Flagstaff and from the highway, see the San Francisco Peaks among the seemingly endless Ponderosa Pine Forest, the largest contiguous forest of ponderosa pines in the world.

Williams will be our first stop along the tour for a chance to experience Route 66, the iconic American highway steeped in rich tradition. While in Williams, guests will have the opportunity to “get their kicks on Route 66” with walks along the original route, explore the local shops and capture souvenir photos highlighting a bygone era in classic American history. Also known as the Will Rodgers Highway, Route 66 is the most recognizable road in the United States and stretched 2,448 miles from Chicago to California upon completion. While you are enjoying Route 66, your guide will pick up your picnic lunch made fresh that morning.

You'll experience about three hours within the National Park marveling at the beauty that is the Grand Canyon. Don't forget to visit the historic El Tovar Lodge and Hopi House in Grand Canyon Village. While at the South Rim of the Grand Canyon National Park, you will have opportunities to walk the rim, shop, capture an unlimited number of photographs, or enjoy your lunch and relax with the best seat in the house.



SONORAN DESERT GUIDED HIKE

An incredible asset to the Southwest Valley, most of **Estrella Mountain Regional Park** remains in its natural state and offers 33 miles of trails, where this desert hike will take place. The exploratory hikes are designed for individuals of **all fitness levels**. Witness breathtaking views of Arizona and capture photographs of the wildlife, geology, and flowers while hiking these trails.

Hikers will be required to sign a Waiver of Liability from the tour company. Comfortable athletic shoes or hiking shoes are required. No flip flops or loose fitting footwear are permitted. Guests are strongly urged to wear a hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen.
