At this 3-hour workshop, participants will learn about the genesis and application of the Principles of Environmental Restoration and discuss how to implement a “Core Team” approach to decision-making. Additionally, participants will have the opportunity to share their own project-specific experiences and benefit from group discussion of opportunities for improvement.

Improvements in the cost and schedule performance of cleanup projects can be realized through application of the Principles as a result of:

- Clear connection between decisions and technical work, enabling the “right-sizing” of project baselines;
- Explicit identification and management of uncertainties, improving situational awareness and increasing confidence in remedial decisions;
- Early scoping and continuous engagement, reducing effort during the document review and revision process and avoiding late-breaking disagreements.

The trainers are a DOE, contractor, consultant, EPA, and state regulator team that has been successfully implementing the Core Team Process at the Savannah River Site since 2000. Case studies and practical examples will be discussed during the workshop.
